### **QIC REPORT (July-Oct 2017)**

1. In response to the circular dated 28.10.2017, in a meeting of QIC, it is suggested that time table for Common subject has been framed by Course Coordinator, HODs are informed to monitor the Quality of Question paper and Evaluation of papers .Also instructed to upload materials of all subjects collected in PEC intranet.
2. It is suggested that a meeting of the QIC comprising all the HOD's could be arranged and HOD's could be instructed to follow question paper pattern for unit test for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3rd and final year students which has been discussed in meeting.
3. By analyzing the performance in terms of results, it was not satisfactory. But absentees were reduced. HODs are informed to conduct retest whose results were satisfactory. Discussion went on Remedial class for Maths and respective department papers.
4. Specifically got feedback from students regarding the conduction of remedial classes. In Connection with that the schedule has been prepared for Maths-I, Maths-II, Maths-III, Maths-IV and other subjects to be conducted simultaneously.
- 5.To train the faculty to set the question paper for the Unit test and model examination ask the university questions have been framed, it is suggested that a meeting of the QIC comprising all the HOD's could be arranged and HOD's could be instructed to train their respective department faculty in this regard.
6. In a meeting of QIC, performance of Unit tests and CAT results were discussed. Based on PPT given by coordinators, strategies has been devised to improve results
7. Apart from regular subjects, remedial subjects test has been conducted and discussed its performance. By analyzing the performance of remedial subject test, there will be good impact in the results when students could appear in university Examination.
8. By analyzing the performance of Model examination marks, it shows the improvement in the count of all clear students.
9. The same procedure whichever is applicable, informed to follow to improve results for First year students. In first year , we categorized the students who secured very low percentage to go for daily test which fetch better results
