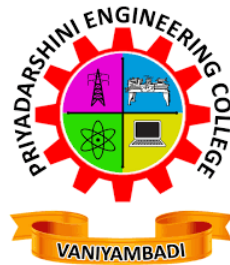

ABOUT THE SESSION:

INVITED EXPERT:

Dr.P.Thambiduari, Research consultant had completed his doctoral degree from department of Earth Sciences at IIT Bombay. He has published in 19 peer reviewed journals and conferences. He is a member of Scientific Advisory Committee in *Isha Foundation* to build the policy “Revitalization of Rivers in India-Draft Policy Recommendation”.

- Through GATE scores, the candidates will be able to apply for admission into IITs, NITs, GFTIs, IISc and many other institute with Financial assistance in post-graduate programs
- Candidates can also avail some reserved seats at IIMs for doctoral programme admissions.
- Top rank holders in some GATE papers are entitled to apply for "Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Fellowship" awarded by CSIR.
- Many companies have signed Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with the GATE organizing committee, for using GATE score as a screening tool for recruiting engineers at entry level positions.

Dr.P.Thambidurai explained the methods on how to qualify GATE oneself without much difficulties. Then he taught the students the key term Innovative way of studying and attending the competitive exam and he has given ample no of examples of Qualifiers.
